VARIETAL ~ Muscat d' Alexandria

STYLE ~ Sweet dessert wine

SERVING ~ As an aperitif

AGEING ~ Small oak barrels for 9 months

- Appellation : *Breedekloof* • Age of vines : 115 years
- Root stock : *Jacquez* • Trellis System : *Bush vines*
- Soil Type : Deep alluvial soils • Irrigation : *Drip irrigation*

HARVEST INFORMATION

- Type : *Hand-picked* • Yield : *3.5 ton per hectare*
- Date : *Middle March* • Sugar : *35° balling*

VINIFICATION

- Sorting of grapes , de-stemmed and crushed. Start fortification process to ensure well balanced flavours and aromas
- 9 months Barrel maturation

CHEMICAL ANALYSIS

- Alcohol ~ 16 vol% • Residual Sugar ~ 236.64
- Total Acid ~ 5.8 • pH ~3.54

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
