VARIETAL ~ Shiraz/Mouvedre/Viognier

STYLE ~ Complex, plummy with red fruit and spicy aromas on the nose with a savoury wild berry finish on the palate. Touches of honeysuckle fruit from Viognier are well integrated with the French oak tannins to give the wine a long, velvety finish

SERVING ~ A perfect companion with beef, mutton and venison

AGEING ~ Ready for immediate enjoyment and for the years to come.
